"CASE SUMMARY"

I, DINESH KUMAR age 29 yrs is suffering from
"CHRONIC INFLAMMATORY MULTIFOCAL DEMYELINATING
MOTOR SENSORY POLY NEUROPATHY" of AUTO-

-IMMUNE-NATURE. In short "CIDP" or demyelinating sensory motor neuropathy. Since 5 yrs. The intensity of weakness, numbness and demyelination in peripheral portion of both upper and lower limbs > other portion of upper and lower limbs > other parts of the body. Due to this disease in spite of being qualified (BE) not able to perform work due to numbness and weakness of all four limbs.

At first in March '02 I consulted Dr. Deepak Arjundas who asked me to perform certain tests like MRI, CSF, NCV, Blood Test etc. On examination of these reports declared having neuropathy disease. Got me admitted in Mercury Hospital for 5 days, and gave me SOLU-MEDROL (steroid) 3 bottles of 500mg daily. After discharge the disease stopped progressing in body but ~~not~~ didn't get cured or improved. Nearly after 1 1/2 yrs the disease started progressing in body, got admitted for the same 5 days

for SOLU-MEDROL. The progression stopped but the disease didn't get cured or improved. Again, the progression of the disease started after 1 1/2 yrs. In 2005, consulted Dr. Pazhani who asked me to perform certain tests and admitted me in hospital for 5 days for IVIg (IV-immunoglobulins). Total 20 bottles, daily 4 bottles each of 5 gms. The progression stopped but no improvement.

Again the progression of disease started after 2 months. Got admitted in hospital for 1 day IVIg course of 4 bottles (each 5gms) After this since the disease is progressive and not getting cured I have to get admitted in hospital every 2-3 months for 1 day IVIg course. Since the disease is of AUTO IMMUNE NATURE there is no tablet to cure this disease in allopathy. Steroid, IVIg, multivitamins etc can just stop the progression of disease but cannot cure it. Doctor also tried immuno-suppressant for 1 yr but didn't work.

I also tried:-

- 1) Ayurvedic Therapy
- 2) Accu-pressure
- 3) Accu-puncture
- 4) Magneto
- 5) Veine therapy
- 6) Yoga. but nothing

helped me. Due to continuous intake of oral steroid for 2 yrs I got steroid-induced CATARACT in both eyes which I got operated before 2 months. I also got fungal skin infection due to these ^{oral} medications. I have stopped all the oral tablets for last 20 days. After attending your session, I and my wife both are confident and felt that my disease is treatable by zero therapy. I can explain ^{all} the other details when I meet you.

Major childhood diseases.

- 1) Chicken-pox = at age of 5 - no allopathy medicines. Taken desi treatment.
- 2) Jaundice = at age of 7. No allopathy medicines. Taken desi treatment.
- 3) Asthma = (due to severe cold - allergy always) for 3 yrs. at age of 14/17. 14 yrs - 17 yrs. Taken allopathy medicines, inhaler.

ULTRA SOUND - WHOLE ABDOMEN

Report:

Liver shows uniform echopattern with no evidence of focal or diffuse pathology. Intra and extra hepatic biliary passages are not dilated. Gall bladder is partially contracted. Wall thickness appear normal.

Pancreas and spleen appear normal. Spleen measures 9.1cms. Portal and splenic veins appear normal.

No evidence of ascites or lymphadenopathy. Diaphragmatic movements are satisfactory.

Right kidney measures 9.8 x 3.5cms.
 Left kidney measures 10.0 x 5.3cms.
 Both kidneys show normal echopattern with no evidence of calculi or calyceal dilatation.

Prostate measures 3.2 x 3.2 x 2.7cms and shows normal echopattern. Seminal vesicles appear normal. Bladder is normal in contour.

MEDIAN MOTOR RIGHT

Order No: 1161152

Findings:

The right median motor and sensory conduction studies are normal. The left median motor conduction shows conduction block and the velocity is reduced. Both ulnar motor conduction studies are normal.

The peroneal motor conduction study on either side are normal. The right tibial motor conduction velocity is reduced, the proximal CMAP is dispersed and there is 20% conduction block. The left tibial motor conduction velocity is reduced, there is more than 50% conduction block.

Both sural SNAP are absent. The right ulnar SNAP velocity is reduced. The left median and ulnar SNAP are absent.

The F waves recorded are unremarkable.

Impression:

This neurophysiological study shows evidence of sensory motor neuropathy. The motor neuropathy shows demyelinating picture with conduction block and it is multifocal.

Findings:

The right median motor conduction study is normal. The F wave from above nerve is normal. The right ulnar motor conduction study shows mild delay in latency. The right ulnar F wave latency is delayed. The left median motor conduction velocity is reduced; the F wave latency is delayed. The left ulnar motor conduction shows delay in latency, the F wave latency is delayed.

The right common peroneal motor conduction is normal, the F wave is delayed. The left common peroneal motor conduction study is normal, the F wave is delayed. The right tibial motor conduction study is normal, the F wave is delayed. The left tibial motor conduction shows conduction block with proximal stimulation, the F wave latency is delayed.

The right median SNAP is normal. The ulnar on either side and left median SNAP shows delay in latency, the amplitude and velocity are reduced. The right sural SNAP is absent. The left sural SNAP shows delay in latency, the amplitude and velocity are reduced.

Impression:

This neurophysiological study shows evidence of demyelinating sensory motor neuropathy involving both upper and lower limbs.

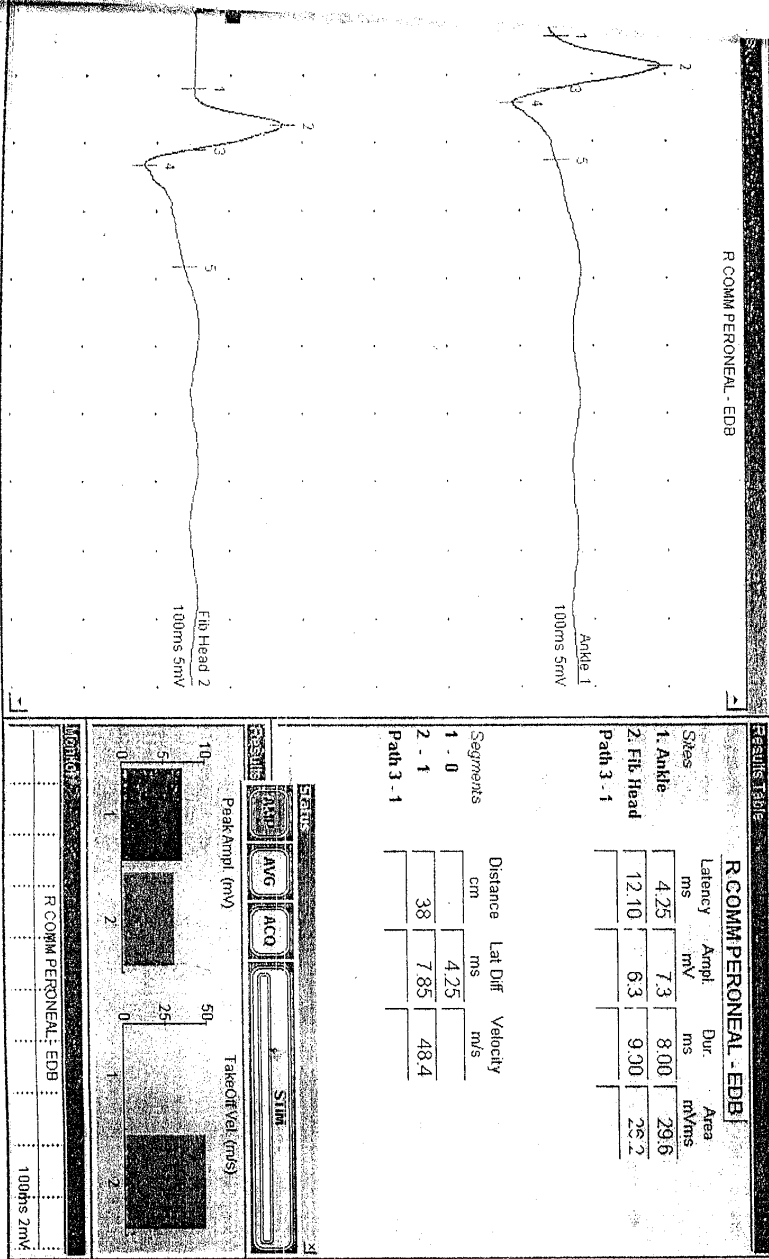

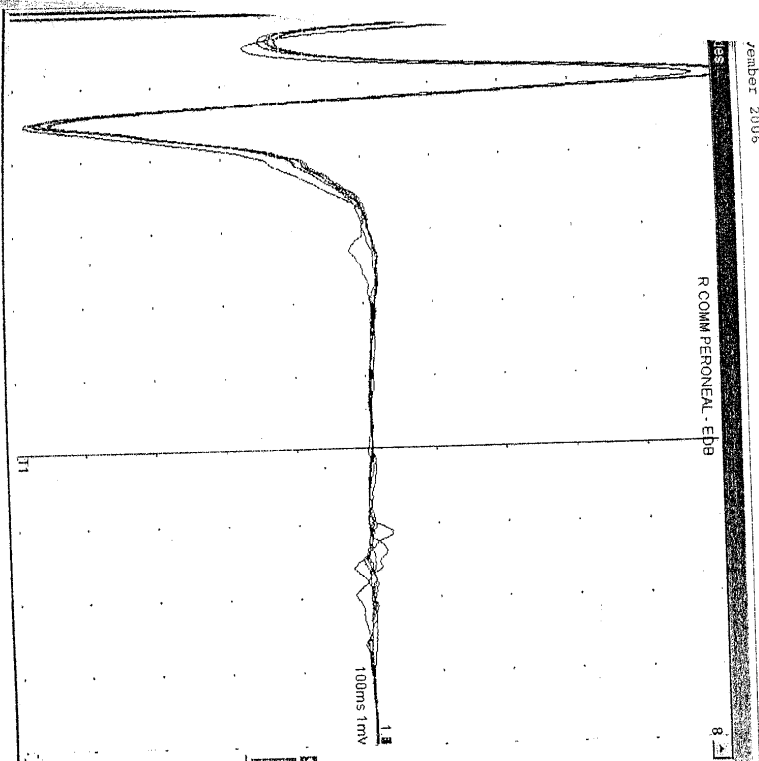
